A friend once told us that she would be hesitant to name a dog Nor'Easter and then Storm for short because it would be hard to live up to. I guess that is probably true but Storm managed to do just that. I guess the best testament to her record is the record itself. In addition to being an accomplished show dog, she had a stellar record of achievement on the Field.

LCM7, LCX6 a combined 16 ASFA/AKC BIFs, winner of the Treybou Grand Prix in Hanover two times. The only other do to do so was her mother Aslan's Dark Silhouette. Several Regional BOB titles. She won the Ridgeback National Specialty, BOB at the II and a number of other II stake wins including the last year she was able to run. She won the Dixie Cup in Georgia, the Art Idleman BIF Perpetual Trophy, the Jesse Reynolds Trophy in Michigan, the Tyler Perpetual trophy in New Jersey, Breeders Stake at the RR National Specialty and a Kennel Stake at the II. She was the RRCUS #1 Coursing Dog twice including the year she left the field in July to whelp a litter of 8 puppies. She did not return to the field until late December and still retained her number one ranking. She had amassed so many bowen points by July, nobody could catch her although many tried.

Her coursing career was cut short at 8 years old by Degenerative Myelopathy. In her ninth year of age she started to limp in May so we knew it was coming. Our vets told us to run her as long as she was able as they felt it would delay the onset. We just had to get her through roll call. In 2011, her last year of coursing at 9 years of age and in spite of DM, she still placed in the top ten, earned her LCM 7, LCX 6, won 13 ASFA/AKC BOBs, 2 BIFs and won the Veteran's class both days at the II. The Storm was over a couple of days before the ACoD in Colorado 2013.
