Can Ch Elana CsCs, Can Fd Ch X, LCM 6 August, 1978 – August, 1991

CsCs, born in August of 1978, became a legend in the lure coursing world from the time of his first trial until well into the mid-80's. With 694 dogs defeated in the US, CsCs garnered 59 Best of Breeds and 19 Best in Fields during his coursing career in the states alone. Only two greyhounds have to this day exceeded and one whippet tied CsCs' record number of BIF's in ASFA Field Trials. To date, no other saluki has earned as many Best in Field placements as CsCs.

In 1980 alone, CsCs won the Colorado Grand National, the Kenmar Knoll Lure Challenge Trophy, the Bandit Grand Prix Challenge Cup, the Circle Cup, and the Katahdin Challenge Cup for Salukis. He continued dominating the lure coursing field in salukis, sometimes sharing the spotlight with his kennel mate, Hillerica Orlando, "Lando", through 1983 winning Best of Breeds and Best in Fields at ASFA trials and ASFA regional trials. CsCs continued to course well into 1985.

Also successful in Canada, CsCs, in 10 trials during 1980, won BOB in all 10 trials and took BIF in 6 of the 10 trials.

CsCs was a very special saluki with not only the drive to course, both lure and on live game, he had a fabulous temperament with other dogs and he loved people. CsCs had none of the normal saluki aloofness, he was truly a 'golden' in saluki clothing! A beautiful black fringed red, he was given to us in the age old Arabic tradition by his breeder, Nell Hyde. CsCs lived the majority of his life in Vermont with Tom and Trina Bianchi and died in August of 1991.

Trapps' to hold Lure Field Trials

Come watch sighthounds race in the Trapp Family Meadow Memorial Day weekend, May 23-25. Hounds run in groups of two or three, instinctively chasing lures made of white plastic strips tied to strings run on pulleys in a 600 to 1000 yard zig-zag course. Judges score them on speed, enthusiasm, follow, agility, and endurance. Lure coursing is a family sport and the hounds are pets.

Some of the breeds you're likely to see are Afghan Hounds, Borzois, Irish Wolfhounds, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Greyhounds, and Whippets. Hounds will be running mid-morning through mid-afternoon.
