find the information that you need. At the same time we want to make it simple for those that come to the web site for the first time to be able to find out about trials in their area. We hope you like it.


# ASFA 40th Anniversary

## Silken Windhound's Provisional Status

approved for Limited Status November 2009 and began running in ASFA field trials in December 2009.

The ASFA Constitution states in "Article X Recognition of Additional Sighthound Breeds; Section 4. Approving Provisional **Recognition**. Upon completion of

The Silken Windhounds were the steps given in Section 2 and 3, the national parent club may apply for Provisional status. To be eligible for Provisional status the new breed must have had a minimum of 10 dogs actively coursing with a minimum of 30 entries in two consecutive or two out of the last three calendar years in which the breed participated in Limited status...."

ASFA records has reported the following numbers for the Silken Windhounds:

<u>Year</u>	Hounds Competing	<u>Entries</u>	New Hounds
2010	125	655	95
2011	109	599	30

In January the ISWS, the Parent Club for Silken Windhounds, upon completion of the above numbers in the 2 previous calendar years, applied to the ASFA Board to be approved to compete at ASFA Field Trials with Provisional Status.

The Board voted to approve the Silken Windhounds for Provisional This will take effect on status. March 1, 2012.

The Silkens will continue to run in the Limited Stake.
