The Board is busy working with their committees at this time. You can be looking forward to the interim reports in September.

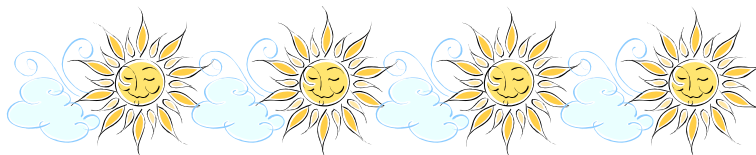
