Eligible Breeds and Registry

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakh, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhound, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughi, Whippets and Provisional breeds may enter the regular stakes. Current Provisional breed: Silken Windhound.

Limited breeds may be entered in the Limited or Singles Stake. Limited Stake breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Pequino) and Portuguese Podengo (Medio and Grande) and must be individually registered by the appropriate registry.

All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC, NGA, FCI, UKC or an ASFA recognized foreign or an ASFA approved registry or possess a CRN from SPDBS.
