Directions to the Site:

Traveling South on I-5

Exit Cottage Grove, 6th Avenue Exit 172.

Turn left and go over freeway. Follow 6th Avenue down the hill and veer toward the left. Sixth Avenue has now become London Road.

Directions once on London Road:

Follow London Road to mile marker 13. The mile markers are small signs on the side of the road.

Right after mile marker 13, you cross a bridge.

About 1/4 mile past the bridge, there are 3 mail boxes on the right side of the road.

Directly opposite the mailboxes is a dirt road (BLM sign on the far left corner).

Turn left onto that dirt road.

Follow the dirt road about 1/4 mile to the Y intersection. Bear left at the Y.

Immediately after the Y is a driveway on the left. Do NOT take that.

Follow the road straight until you come to a stop sign and the Whippet Watch sign.

Turn left immediately after the stop sign and follow the gravel road down to the field.

The pasture gates will be open,

Parking is right next to the barn or in the field, depending on weather.

Traveling North on I-5 from Rice Hill, Exit 150 (short way to field)

Take the Scotts Valley Exit, Exit 154.

Cross at the yield sign and turn right on Scotts Valley Rd.

Go 5 miles to the ONLY left turn, London Hill Rd. (portions are not paved).

Go 5 miles over the hill to London Rd. (portions are not paved).

Turn right on London Rd. and proceed about 3 miles to mile marker 13.

Follow directions above to the field.

Traveling North on I-5 to Cottage Grove (long way around)

Take the first Cottage Grove Exit south of town, Exit 170.

You will follow the road left over the freeway, and drive parallel to the freeway for about 2 miles.

At Latham Rd., turn right. There is a Weyerhaeuser lumber mill on the north corner, turn immediately before the lumber mill.

Follow Latham back under the freeway until it dead ends at 6th Avenue.

Turn right onto 6th/London Road. Follow directions above to the field.

All Hounds entering Open, Veteran or Limited Stakes for the first time MUST include a completed ASFA Certification or Waiver Form (with proof of title) and a copy of the hound's registration certificate (registration requirement waived for NGA Greyhounds only; certification waived for Single Stake entries only).

ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, Sloughis, and Whippets may be entered in the regular stakes.

Limited breeds may be entered in the Limited Stake or the Singles Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno), Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande), and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (ILP/PAL included), the NGA, the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from the SPDBS. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the NGA.

REGULAR STAKES OFFERED

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Any ASFA Field Champion

VETERAN STAKE: Any eligible hound whose age is at least six years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least five years, and Afghan Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis and Whippets whose age shall be at least seven years. Points go toward V-FCh or V-LCM titles.

LIMITED STAKE: Any eligible sighthound of a Limited breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.

SINGLE STAKE: Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles stake. Limited breeds are not eligible for these titles.

BEST IN FIELD will be offered.

Conditions of Entry: All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial • Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more • Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call. • Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered; hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake • Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched • All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.




