Eligibility. Any hound that is ASFA pointed, or is pointed in its country of residence, or is AKC pointed, is eligible to enter a Regional Invitational in an appropriate stake, including Single Stake, if offered. Proof of non-ASFA points for hounds should be in the form of a photocopy of the certificate, or a page of formal printing, included with the entry. For a Limited bread to be eligible, the entry must have one first placement, or two second placements, with competition in the Limited Stake. All points or placements must be earned by the closing date of the event. An eligible hound may be entered in any number of Regional Invitationals. Hounds entered in the Single Stake are not eligible to be entered in Breeder, Kennel, or Bench stakes.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhound, Sloughis, Whippets, and Provisional breeds may be entered in the regular stakes. Limited breeds may be entered in the Limited Stake or the Singles Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno), Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande), and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP & PAL), the NGA, the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from the SPDBS.

INCOMPLETE, UNSIGNED OR CONDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. Entries will not be acknowledged by mail or telephone. Email, IM, or text Judi for confirmation.

REGULAR STAKES OFFERED

Open Stake: Any eligible sighthound that has met the certification requirements and earned at least one ASFA point, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

Field Champion Stake: Any ASFA Field Champion.

Veteran Stake: Any hound that has met certification requirements and earned at least one ASFA point, or equivalent point in its country of residence, and whose age exceeds six years, except Irish Wolfhounds, whose age shall exceed five years, and Afghans, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, and Whippets, whose age shall exceed seven years.

<u>Singles Stake</u>: Any eligible sighthound, including those disqualified to run in another stake. Not eligible to run in Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles stake. Limited breeds are not eligible for these titles.

<u>Limited Stake:</u> Any eligible sighthound of a limited stake breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to run in Best of Breed or Best in Field

Best in Field will be offered.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial.
- Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more.
- Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused at roll call and the entry fee will be refunded.
- Spayed, neutered, monorchid, or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered.
- Hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake.
- Hounds not present at time of Roll Call will be scratched without refund of entry fee.
- All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- There will be no certification runs during the trial. Certifications will be offered on Friday afternoon.
- Any hound that displays aggressive behavior during trial hours will be excused for the day without refund of entry fees.
- A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress.
- A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any waste material left on the grounds by a dog or person. Waste disposal equipment will be available
- Battery powered, continuous loop lure machine will be used; backup equipment will be available.
- Lure will consist of white plastic strips and rabbit hide.

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

From the west: Take the second US30 exit (#9) from I-84. Turn right onto Idaho 72 (SE 1ª Av). Go straight at Sand Hollow Road to get on Idaho 52, still heading east. Proceed to Vanderdasson Road

From the east: Take exit #42 (Ten Mile) from I-84. Proceed on N. Ten Mile 4.7 miles to Idaho 20/26 (Chinden Rd.) Turn left, go 2 miles to Idaho 16 and turn right. Proceed on Idaho 16 to the junction with Idaho 52 and go straight 4.75 miles to Vanderdasson Road.

Vanderdasson Road is between mileposts 25 and 26 on Idaho 52. Tom's Cabin Café is approximately on the opposite corner. Turn north onto Vanderdasson and proceed across the railroad tracks. The driveway to the field is a right turn immediately after crossing the bridge over the irrigation ditch. The address on the mailbox is 1114. There will be signs on Idaho 52 and on Vanderdasson indicating the direction to the field.

We will have coffee & edibles on the field each morning – donations always welcome. NO LUNCH will be provided Sunday, But we will have potluck lunch and dinner on SATURDAY, as well as a possible impromptu Friday night gathering. Please bring your favorite dishes and prepare for a bunch of fun, and maybe prizes! We promise there will be great food and company.

The field will be set up for free practice runs on Friday around 3 pm, and we will have a judge available at that time for certification runs at \$10 per certifying hound. Contact Judi at (208) 841-0595 the week before the trial if you have questions. SISFA can NOT provide bye dogs, so please make sure you have a dog with which to certify. There will be no certification runs during the weekend, except as approved by the lure operator & crew, and absolutely NONE during the trial! Saturday practice runs can only be held with a volunteer field crew after the trial & after the field has been reset for Sunday. ALL equipment must be left in operable condition.

And for the last reminder: the weather in Idaho's Treasure Valley is always unpredictable. In late October it is *typically* clear and sunny, with crisp mornings and cool afternoons, but don't forget your sunscreen, EZ Up, polar fleece, and rain gear just in case.

Please remember the entry for all first-time-entered dogs must include a copy of their current registration, and either a hound certification or a certification waiver. Entries cannot (and will not) be accepted without this.
