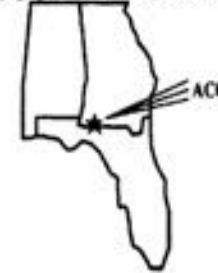

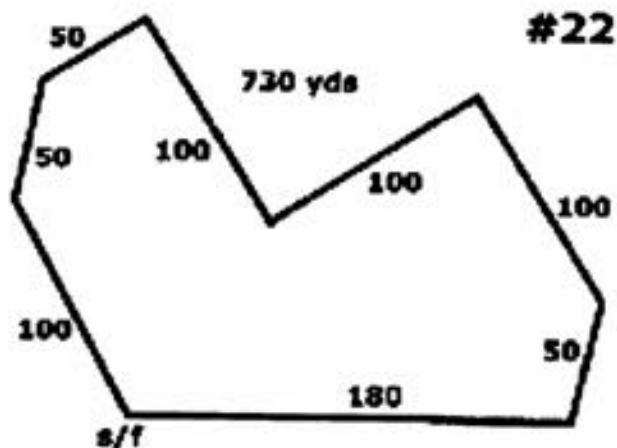

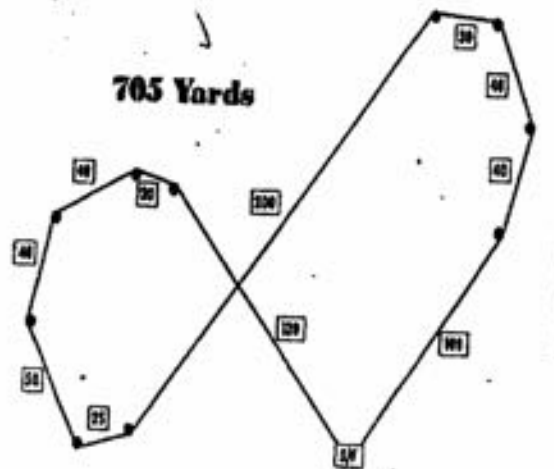

**Trial hours: 8 AM Saturday & Sunday until complete, trial roll call 9 AM Saturday & Sunday.** Entries will NOT be acknowledged by mail. Early entries, with payment must be received no later than February 7, 2019. No phone entries, late, unsigned, incomplete or conditional entries will be accepted.

### Eligible breeds & registry

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Silken Windhounds, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, and Whippets may be entered in the regular stakes. Limited breeds include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Espanol, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portugese Podengo (Pequeno), Portugese Podengo (Medio & Grande), and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry. All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP & PAL), the NGA, the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from the SPDBS or an AKC SC title, a photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hounds first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the NGA. All hounds will be checked for breed disqualifications. Late, conditional, unsigned, incomplete or unpaid entries will not be accepted.

### Stakes Offered

**Open** - any eligible sighthound that has met certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champion of record.

**Field Champion** - any ASFA Field Champion.

**Veteran** – any eligible sighthound whose age is at least 6 years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least 5 years; and Afghan Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis and Whippets whose age shall be at least 7 years that has met certification requirements. Points go toward V-FCH or V-LCM titles. **Singles** – any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible for BOB or BIF. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP or CPX titles from the singles stakes. Limited breeds are not eligible for these titles.

**Limited** - any eligible sighthound of a limited or provisional stake breed that has not met certification requirements. The winner of this class is not eligible to compete in BOB and/or BIF event courses.

**BIF** – offered on Saturday. **BIF** – will not be offered on Sunday.

### Conditions of Entry

All entries must be 1 year or older on the day of the trial. Stakes will be split if entry in any 1 stake is 20 or more at the time of the draw. Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications and lame hounds will be excused, and entry fee refunded if refund is requested. All hounds will be checked for breed disqualifications; spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds w/o breed disqualifications are eligible. Hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the single stake. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. Hounds will run twice in trios, if possible, or in braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. A \$5.00 fine will be imposed for any loose hound on the field not competing in the course in progress. A battery-powered continuous loop lure system will be used. Spare equipment will be on hand. The lure will consist of highly visible white plastic strips.

**From the North (Atlanta) avoiding I-75:**

The roads are good and there is not much traffic. Be careful there are often speed traps on US 27 south of Columbus and on the road going into and out of Lumpkin, GA.

- I-85 South from Atlanta
- I-185 South to Columbus (Exit #21 from I-85)
- US 27 South (Exit 1A from I-185) to Bainbridge
- US 27 & US 84 bypass around Bainbridge
- Take GA 97/Faceville Highway
- Turn Right onto GA 97 at the top of the ramp
- Entrance to the field will be about 4.2 miles on the left. Horseshoe Bend Road will be on your Right.

**From the North (Atlanta) using I-75:**

- I-75 South from Atlanta
- Take US 319 South from Tifton towards Thomasville
- US 84 West from Thomasville towards Bainbridge
- US 27 & US 84 bypass around Bainbridge
- Take GA 309
- Turn Right onto GA 309 at the top of the ramp.
- At the light, turn Left onto GA 97/Faceville Highway.
- Entrance to the field will be about 4.2 miles on the left. Horseshoe Bend Road will be on your Right.

**From South (Tallahassee):**

- Take I 10 West to Exit #192, US 90 West towards Quincy
- Go approximately 12 miles on US 90 W to Quincy
- In Quincy, at the square, turn Right at 3rd light onto Adams Street, which becomes Florida 267
- At GA state line the road becomes GA 302. Keep going straight. Be careful not to turn onto Spur GA 302.
- Merge onto Faceville Highway - GA 97 north (GA 302 ends)
- Continue another 5.8 miles on Faceville Highway to entrance to the field on Right - between mile markers 16 & 17. Horseshoe Bend Road will be on your Left (approximately 18.8 miles from Quincy).

**From the Palmer Motel Bainbridge, GA:**

- Go north on US Route 27/Tallahassee Highway 1.3 miles to stop light at Louise Street (the next light after you pass under Hwy 84/bypass).
- Go left (west) on Louise Street which will turn into GA 97/Faceville Highway for about 5 miles. Entrance to field will be on your left, opposite Horseshoe Bend Road. The A&A Convenience Store is on the left just before the entrance to the field.

- Go north on US Route 27/Tallahassee Highway 0.4 miles to stop light at Louse Street (the next light after you pass under Hwy 84/bypass).
- Go left (west) on Louise Street which will turn into GA 97/Faceville Highway for 5 miles. Entrance to field will be on your left, opposite Horseshoe Bend Road. The A&A Convenience Store is on the left just before the entrance to the field.
