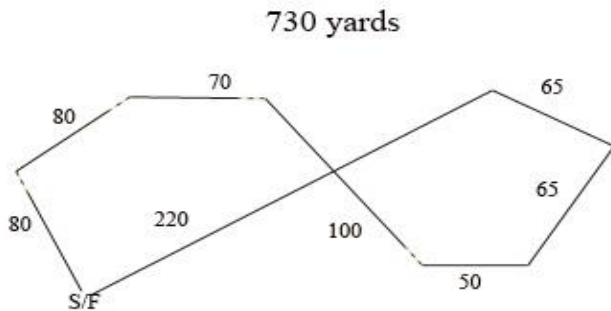

ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco dell’Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, Sloughis, and Whippets.

Limited breeds may be entered in the Limited Stake or the Singles Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno), Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande), and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP & PAL), the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from the SPDBS.

A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound’s first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the NGA.

REGULAR STAKES OFFERED

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound that has met certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Any ASFA Field Champion

VETERAN STAKE: Any eligible hound whose age is at least six years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least five years, and Afghan Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis and Whippets whose age shall be at least seven years. Points go toward V-Fch or V-LCM titles.

LIMITED STAKE: Any eligible sighthound of a Limited breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to compete in Best of Breed or Best in Field.

SINGLE STAKE: Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPS titles from the Singles stake. Limited breeds are not eligible for these titles.

LURE COURSING INSTINCT (LCI) STAKE: Open to NON sighthounds and sighthound mixes. All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP & PAL) or the UKC. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each dog’s first ASFA field trial entry. Dogs without a recognized registry number may obtain an ASFA ID number for a \$10 registration fee at time of entry.

Small Open: for dogs 17-1/2 inches or less at the withers and / or brachycephalic (“flat-faced”) dogs who have not achieved the title of LCC. **Small Senior:** for dogs 17-1/2 inches or less at the withers and/or brachycephalic dogs who have achieved the title of LCC. **Small Veteran:** for dogs 17-1/2 inches or less at the withers and/or brachycephalic dogs over the age of 7 years.

Large Open: for dogs over 17-1/2 inches at the withers who have not achieved the title of LCC. **Large Senior:** is for dogs over 17-1/2 inches at the withers who have achieved the title of LCC. **Large Veteran:** for dogs over 17-1/2 inches at the withers who are over the age of 7 years.

Sighthound Mix Open: for dogs with a sighthound breed in its background who have not achieved the title of LCC. **Sighthound Mix Senior:** for dogs with sighthound breed in its background who have achieved the title of LCC. **Sighthound Mix Veteran:** for dogs with sighthound breed in its background over the age of 7 years.

When running as a stake within a regular ASFA trial, Small will run 50% of the ASFA course as laid out for the sighthounds up to a maximum of 400 yards. All other stakes will run the full ASFA laid out course length.

Conditions of Entry: All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial ● Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more ● Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call. ● Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered; hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake ● Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched ● All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.

Equipment: Type of lure machine: battery-powered continuous-loop system. ● Type of lures: highly-visible white plastic strips ● Back-up equipment will be available.

(Continue about 15 miles WEST from KC's on Route 20 into Richfield Springs for 24-hour PriceChopper grocery store, also Stewart's Convenience & Fuel, Sunoco and McDonald's.)

Kelly's Deli is about 2 miles west of KC's: gas station, propane tank exchange & convenience store, for early a.m. coffee and sandwiches. Hours: 7 a.m. – 8 p.m. until Labor Day, then 7:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. 4964 US Hwy 20 (intersection of Rts 20 & 80) • Springfield Center, NY 13468-2000 • (315) 858-1630. **To reach the field from Kelly's, continue on Rt 80 North for 10 miles, then turn right onto Elwood Rd.**

At Exit 28: Dunkin' Donuts, TA Travel Center with restaurant (gas & diesel), AmBest truck stop and restaurant (gas & diesel), McDonalds.

Exit 30 RED ROOF INN (new—was Herkimer Hotel) [about 17 miles from the field] NYS Thruway / I-90 – **Exit 30, Herkimer NY 13350** • (315) 866-0490 • (877) 656-6835 • Turn right off the Thruway exit, behind Denny's restaurant (which is open 24 hours).

Also at Exit 30: all sorts of shopping within the town of Herkimer (Super Walmart open 24 hours, restaurants, diners, various fast food places; McDonald's and Denny's open 24 hours).

NEW OPTION

There is a **Motel 6 in Mohawk/Ilion**, the same distance away as the Red Roof Inn in Herkimer. Instead of turning right at the light at the Fastrac, you turn left. Possible alternative if everything else fills up. **Motel 6: 345 E Main St, Ilion NY 13357, (315) 895-8777.** 16 miles from our field (23 minutes). **To Motel 6 from our field:** At the end of our road (Elwood), turn left, then an immediate right onto Rt 168 W. Continue for about 15 miles to Rt 28 N, bear right. Turn left at 2nd light (Fastrac on the left). Continue about a mile to Motel 6 on the right (Rt 5S/E Main St).

DIRECTIONS

DO NOT totally depend on your GPS device the first time you attend, or you may end up in a cow field (not kidding here).

(Starkville is 14 miles southwest of the New York State Thruway Exit 29)

FROM THE EAST or NORTHEAST: New York State Thruway (I-90) to Exit 29 (mm 194 – Canajoharie, Sharon Springs, Fort Plain, Cooperstown, Oneonta, St. Johnsville). Pay the toll – the big white Beech Nut Foods factory will be on your right, a Betty Beaver's Getty station & small convenience store is on the left. Turn RIGHT at the stop sign onto State Route (SR) 5-S West. Go thru the little traffic light in Canajoharie, and continue on SR 5-S West for about 3 miles to the village of Fort Plain. Drive across a small steel bridge over the canal -- turn LEFT at the light onto SR 80 South. **Turn RIGHT to Stewart's gas station/convenience store if you need fuel, or to pick up ice or snacks or use the restroom – there is nothing between Fort Plain and the house. Watch the speed limits, & make sure your seat belts are fastened; heavy fines up here.** Stay on SR 80 South for about 9 miles – then watch for a 'Speed Zone Ahead' sign (35 mph) and a small painted sign Village of Starkville. Please slow down (watch for cats, dogs, kids, tractors & Amish buggies). **Elwood Road (CR 74) is the first road on the LEFT immediately after the sign for SR 168.** (If you reach Rt. 168 on the right, you passed Elwood Rd.)

Turn LEFT onto Elwood, continue for 1.5 miles – the road snakes left, then right, then straightens out. Continue up the hill (the road snakes again at the top). Wolfwind is the first farm on the RIGHT after the fields. (Amish farm on the left). **Access to the field is via the gravel driveway – signs will be posted.** Farm house is on the other side of the line of tall evergreen trees – Cedar brown house, buckskin trim, green roofs, black mailbox #381, small circular drive. [About 13 miles from Exit 29.]

FROM THE WEST or NORTHWEST: New York State Thruway (I-90) East to Exit 30 (Herkimer). Pay the toll, turn LEFT at the traffic light, cross over the Mohawk River & Erie Canal bridge. Continue through that traffic light, turn LEFT at the next traffic light onto SR 28 South (**Fastrac convenience store/gas station will be on your right after you make the turn – it's the last store & gas/diesel station before the house from that direction**). Continue south on SR 28 for about ¼ mile, then turn LEFT onto Rt. 168 (before the big hill). Continue on Rt. 168 for about 15.3 miles (curvy, hilly road) – at the end, turn LEFT onto State Rt. 80, and immediately RIGHT onto Elwood Road. Follow Elwood Rd 1.5 miles around and up the hill, our place is the first farm on the right past the fields. [About 17 miles from Exit 30.]

FROM THE SOUTH (Binghamton area): Take Rt. 88 EAST to Exit 13 (Oneonta). Turn LEFT onto Rt. 205 NORTH – follow to State Route 80 NORTH. Continue on SR 80 North through historic Cooperstown, continue for 10 miles, go through the intersection at State Rt. 20 (Springfield Center) (**Kelly's gas station & convenience store is on the right**). Continue on SR 80 North for about 9 miles (very curvy, hilly road) - **Elwood Rd is the first RIGHT past Rt. 168.** Follow Elwood Rd 1.5 miles around and up the hill, our place is the first farm on the right past the fields. [About 55 miles from Exit 13.]

ALTERNATE FROM THE SOUTH (Binghamton area): Continue on Rt 205 NORTH onto NY-80/NY-205, stay LEFT at fork to follow NY-205, then make a slight LEFT onto NY-28 for about 9 miles (Richfield Springs). Make a RIGHT onto US-20 EAST, continue for about 6.3 mile to the traffic light at the intersection of NY-80 (Springfield Center) (**Kelly's gas station & convenience store is on the right diagonal**). Make a LEFT at the light onto NY-80 NORTH, continue for about 9 miles (very curvy, hilly road) - **Elwood Road is the first RIGHT past Rt. 168.** Follow as above.

We will follow State and local guidelines.

1. All Field Committee and Lure Operators will wear facial coverings.
2. All participants will wear facial coverings.
3. No food will be served, bring your own breakfast and lunches. Sorry!!! Please bring your own food, water and shade for yourself and your dogs. None will be available at this time.
4. We ask that you park at a safe distance from each other.
5. Roll Call will be done at everyone's car. The roll call committee will wear gloves and facial coverings. We will ask the owners of females to wipe their dogs and show the inspection committee the tissue.
6. Wickets will be wiped down after each dog.
7. We will have instant hand sanitizer and wet wipes everywhere.
8. We will prop open the portapotty when not in use for more air flow to cut down on bacteria. Large handicapped portapotty will be available, with spray disinfectant.
9. Huntmasters will stand 6 feet from the dogs after inspecting blankets and slip leads.
10. At the starting line, all dogs will stand 6 feet apart.
11. Practice social distancing the best you can. We all have been cooped up but act responsibly!!
12. Please be aware of the running orders will be posted as usual, if needed, we will use a bull horn to notify you if you choose to stay by your car.
