ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY LURE CHASING INSTINCT (LCI) STAKE

All dogs entered must have a registration number via one of the following:
(A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each dog's first ASFA field trial entry).

- A. AKC/CKC Registration as one of the recognized breeds.
- B. CKC (CCN)/AKC Canine Partners, which is for mixed-breed dogs and dogs ineligible for AKC/CKC registration.
- C. Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) program, which is for purebred dogs that cannot be fully registered with the AKC to participate in AKC events.
- D. Foundation Stock Service® (FSS), which is for recorded breeds on the road to full AKC recognition.
- E. United Kennel Club (UKC) registration as one of the recognized breeds.
- F. Dogs without a recognized registry number may obtain a unique and permanent ASFA ID number for a one time \$10 registration fee at time of entry (entry form below). The Trial Secretary will submit a copy of the form with the records. The owner will retain a copy as proof of request and payment until a permanent number is provided.

LURE COURSING INSTINCT (LCI) STAKES:

Small Open: Dogs 17-1/2” or less at the withers and/or brachycephalic (“flat-faced”) dogs who have not achieved the title of LCC.

Small Senior: Dogs 17-1/2” or less at the withers and/or brachycephalic dogs who have achieved the title of LCC.

Small Veteran: Dogs 17-1/2” or less at the withers and/or brachycephalic dogs over the age of 7 years.

Large Open: Dogs over 17-1/2” at the withers who have not achieved the title of LCC.

Large Senior: Dogs over 17-1/2” at the withers who have achieved the title of LCC.

Large Veteran: Dogs over 17-1/2” at the withers who are over the age of 7 years.

Sighthound Mix Open: Dogs with a sighthound breed in its background who have not achieved the title of LCC.

Sighthound Mix Senior: Dogs with sighthound breed in its background who have achieved the title of LCC.

Sighthound Mix Veteran: Dogs with sighthound breed in its background over the age of 7 years.

- When running as a stake within a regular ASFA trial, Small will run 50% of the ASFA course as laid out for the sighthounds up to a maximum of 400 yards.
- All other stakes will run the full ASFA laid out course length.
- All entries must be one year or older on the day of the Trial.
- Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused at roll call.
- All hounds will run twice.
- All entries must be one year or older on the day of the Trial
- \$5.00 fine assessed for any loose hound not participating in the course.
- Practice on Saturday, weather, equipment, and time permitting, \$5.00 per run.

ECHO COVID General LCI Rules

A medical doctor and student nurse will be on site to ensure adherence to all Health Canada, Ontario Provincial and local guidelines.

- Competitors and FT committee to complete online COVID screening Questionnaire prior to trial.
- Running order will be posted in advance, grouped by small/sighthound mix and large dogs, and people with more than one dog.
- Face coverings are required for all Field Committee members and volunteers.
- Face coverings are required for all competitors.
- Extra masks are available for \$2 donation.

Roll Call:

- To be performed at the competitors' car.
- Human COVID-19 questionnaire checked.
- Sighthounds and LCI dogs will be measured with minimal contact.
- LCI: Rolling roll call depending on start time.
- Owners will swipe their female dog(s) and show the inspection committee the tissue.

Running the dogs:

- Lures will be a minimum of 2 metres apart.
- You will be allowed to leave your car no more than 30 minutes before your predetermined running time. You may dress, potty and warm up your dog.

Once you have finished Running your dog:

- Please go directly to your vehicle.
- Only one person handles the ribbons.
- There will be hand sanitizer available in designated areas.

Unfortunately, for the time being, we must forego some traditions, such as convening for a bite to eat and the evening social. However, in the spirit of the sport, we can still get out, maybe catch up with a friend and have a fun day with our dogs.
