



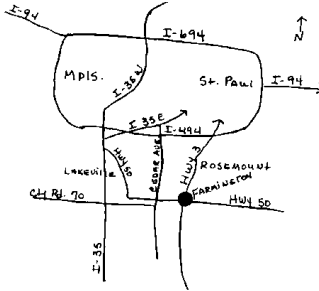

## Eligible Breeds & Registration

Purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneci dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, Sloughis and Whippets may be entered in all stakes, except Limited and LCI.

Limited breeds may be entered in the Limited Stake or Singles Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno), and Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande). They must be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

All entries in the above stakes shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP and PAL), the NGA, the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from the SPDBS. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the NGA

Lure Chasing Instinct (LCI) Stake is open to all non-sighthound breeds and mixed breeds. See "LCI STAKES" section below for registration requirements and stake details.

## Stakes Offered

### REGULAR STAKES

**OPEN STAKE:** For any eligible sighthound that has met certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

**FIELD CHAMPION STAKE:** For any ASFA Field Champion of record. Except that hounds whose owner records show them to be ASFA Field Champions may be entered for a period up to 90 days without official certification. Hounds whose owner records show them to have met the requirements for the Field Champion title may be changed from the Open stake to the Field Champion stake provided notification is made to the Field Trial Secretary prior to roll call. Hounds determined to be not eligible to compete in the Field Champion stake will forfeit all points and placements earned in that stake toward an LCM.

**VETERAN STAKE:** For any eligible sighthound whose age is at least six years and who has met certification requirements. Except Irish Wolfhounds, whose age shall be at least five years, and Afghans, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis and Whippets, whose age shall be at least seven years. Points earned in this stake go toward V-FCH and V-LCM titles.

### LIMITED STAKE:

For any eligible sighthound of a Limited breed that has met the certification requirements. All rules pertaining to Open Stake shall apply to Limited Stake, except when inconsistent with the following. No ASFA points or placements towards a Field Championship or an LCM will be awarded. Limited Stake breeds are not eligible to compete for Best in Field or Best in Event.

**SINGLES STAKE:** For any eligible sighthound including sighthounds disqualified to run in other stakes. Each hound runs alone and is not eligible to compete for Best of Breed, Best in Field, or Best in Event. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP & CPX titles from this stake.

## **LCI STAKES**

### **REGISTRATION FOR LCI (LURE COURSING INSTINCT) STAKES**

All dogs entered in LCI stake must have a registration number. If your dog is registered under any of options A – E below, then you must attach a copy (not the original) of the registration certificate to your dog's first ASFA trial entry form. If your dog is not registered under any of the options A – E below, then you may obtain a registration number under paragraph F below.

- A. A registration from AKC or CKC as one of their recognized breeds, or
- B. A registration from AKC Canine Partners or CKC (CCN) as a mixed-breed or other ineligible dog for registration under A (above), or
- C. A registration from AKC PAL (Purebred Alternative Listing), as a pure breed dog ineligible for registration under A (above), or
- D. An FSS (Foundation Stock Service) breed, as a member of a breed that is in the process of obtaining full AKC recognition, or
- E. A registration from UKC (United Kennel Club), which is an international dog registry that focuses on performance, or
- F. If your dog has no registration, you can register your dog with ASFA at the time your dog enters his/her first trial as follows:
  - Complete the registration form below
  - Attach a one time registration fee of \$10, payable to ASFA
  - Submit the registration form and fee to the Field Trial Secretary along with for your dog's first ASFA trial entry form.

The Field Trial Secretary will submit the registration form and fee to ASFA along with the trial records. Please retain a copy for your records until you receive a permanent registration number from ASFA.

### **LCI (LURE COURSING INSTINCT) STAKES ~~~ NEW STAKES ~~~**

- Small** - For LCI dogs of 17-1/2" or less at the withers and for all brachycephalic (flat faced) dogs
- Small Open Stake – for Small dogs that have not achieved the title of LCC (Lure Chasing Champion).
  - Small Senior Stake – for Small dogs that have achieved the title of LCC.
  - Small Veteran Stake – for Small dogs that are over the age of 7.
- Large** - For LCI dogs that are over 17-1/2" at the withers
- Large Open Stake – for Large dogs that have not achieved the title of LCC (Lure Chasing Champion).
  - Large Senior Stake – for Large dogs that have achieved the title of LCC.
  - Large Veteran Stake – for Large dogs that are over the age of 7.
- Sighthound Mix** - For dogs with sighthound breed in its background
- Sighthound Mix Open Stake – for Sighthound Mix dogs that have not achieved the title of LCC (Lure Chasing Champion).
  - Sighthound Mix Senior Stake – for Sighthound Mix dogs that have achieved the title of LCC.
  - Sighthound Mix Veteran Stake – for Sighthound Mix dogs that are over the age of 7.

**BEST IN FIELD WILL NOT BE OFFERED, BUT BEST IN EVENT WILL BE OFFERED ON SUNDAY.** Best of Breed winners from both Saturday and Sunday that ran both days without scratches or forfeits are eligible to compete for the Minnesota Cup. The Minnesota Cup run will follow the BOB run-offs on Sunday. Singles, Limited and LCI are not eligible for Best in Event.

### **Conditions of Entry (applies to all stakes)**

- Hounds must be one year of age or older on day of trial.
- Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any stake is 20 or more.
- Females in season, lame hounds/dogs and those that are unfit to course will be excused at roll call.
- Hounds with breed disqualifications that are entered in regular breed stakes will be excused at roll call.
- Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid without breed disqualifications may be entered in regular hound breed stakes.
- Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter Singles Stake.
- Hounds/dogs not present at the time of roll call will be scratched.
- All hounds/dogs will be run twice unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
- All hounds/dogs will run in trios if possible, or braces (except in Singles and LCI stakes).
- A separate entry form is required for each dog for each day.
- All participants must read, understand, sign, and comply with the ASFA Lure Coursing Event COVID-19 Acknowledgement and Liability Waiver

### **Other Information**

- Battery powered continuous loop lure machine will be used. Backup equipment will be available.
- Lure will consist of highly visible plastic strips.
- Exhibitors are requested to not bring bitches known to be in season to the field.
- There will be a \$5.00 fine assessed for any loose hound not participating in the course.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Trial Committee.
- The field is partially fenced.
- Children must be under control of their parents or guardians at all times.

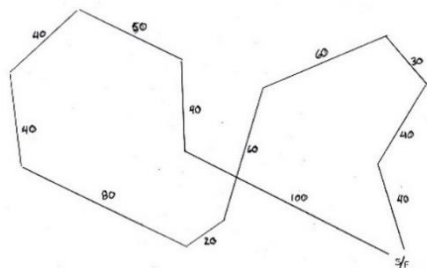

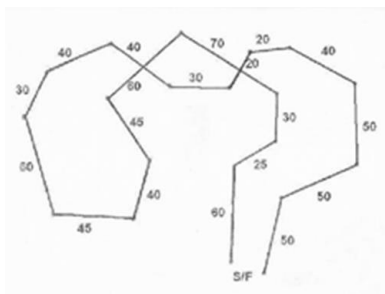
## Course Plans

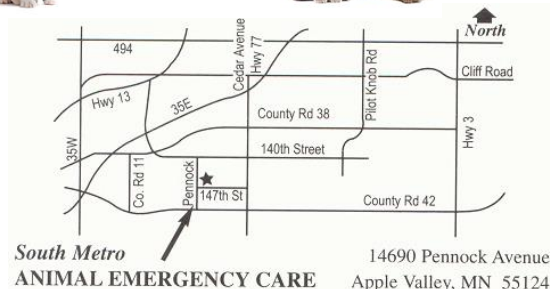

## Procedures for COVID-19 Safety

- ✓ We will follow State of Minnesota and local guidelines.
- ✓ Bring your own facial covering. All participants will be required to wear facial coverings when not in their cars.
- ✓ No food will be served, bring your own breakfast and lunch, coffee, water & beverages.
- ✓ We ask that you park at a safe distance from other cars. This may mean that you will not find parking in the shade. Accordingly, be sure to bring plenty of shade for your dog(s) and yourself.
- ✓ There is no water available on or near the North Field. Bring your own water.
- ✓ Roll Call and Inspection will be done at you car, instead of in a central location. The roll call committee will wear gloves and facial coverings. We will ask the owners of females to wipe their dogs and show the inspection committee the tissue.
- ✓ For dogs that require wicketing, the wickets will be wiped down after each dog.
- ✓ Bring your own face covering, hand sanitizer, and wet wipes.
- ✓ Restroom doors will be left open for airflow.
- ✓ Huntmasters will stand 6 feet from the dogs after inspecting blankets and slip leads.
- ✓ At the starting line, all dogs will stand 6 feet apart.
- ✓ Practice social distancing. Act responsibly!!
- ✓ The running order will be posted as usual, and if needed, we will use a bull horn to notify you if you choose to stay by your car.

- ✓ Bring your own poop bags, pens, paper – avoid having to borrow from others.

**PRACTICES & HOUND CERTIFICATIONS** Except for Hounds entered in Singles Stake that may certify before the trial, certs & hound practices will be available after the trial on **Saturday** (weather, equipment & field conditions permitting). The fee for a certification run is \$5. Make arrangements for a hound to run with, and have the proper form for the judge to sign. Certifications will be run before practice runs as a courtesy to the judges.

**REFUNDS** - MCA will refund entry fees for anyone who cannot or should not attend the trial due to illness, possible illness, or exposure to illness during the pandemic. Contact the Field Trial Secretary. MCA also provides refunds of entry fees for dogs that are in season or lame, so long as the Field Trial Secretary is notified of the situation **before roll call**. If your dog comes in season or becomes lame before the Trial, and you will not be attending the Trial for that reason, you must notify the Field Trial Secretary BEFORE roll to claim a refund. If the Field Trial Secretary does not receive notice before roll call, MCA will not issue a refund.
