Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhound, Sloughis, and Whippets may be entered in the regular stakes. Limited breeds may be entered in the Limited Stake or the Singles Stake. ATTENTION: As of January 1, 2012, the Singles stake is now a regular stake which means it must be offered at all ASFA Field Trials, except at Regional Invitationals, International Invitationals, and Breed Specialty Trials. Since it is a regular stake, the entry for the Singles stake cannot be limited in number

The ribbon awarded to the highest placing qualifying Single is navy/gold at a regular ASFA field trial. If there is a tie for first place, ties shall be run off using the same protocol as judging the Singles stake. Hounds competing in the Singles stake are eligible to earn a Title of Coursing Proficiency (TCP) and a Title of Coursing Proficiency Excellent (CPX). These titles are not available to hounds in the Limited Breeds.
