



A battery powered CONTINUOUS LOOP lure machine will be used; backup equipment will be available. Lure will consist of highly visible plastic. The club reserves the right to alter the course as required by weather and/or field condition on the day of the trial. Courses will be reversed for finals, run-offs and again for BOB. The field is not fenced, but the course is well away from the main road.

Breeds & Eligibility: Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirnecho dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, Sloughis, Whippets, provisional breeds, if any, may be entered in the regular stakes. Limited stake breeds, if any, may be entered in Limited Stake or Singles Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred Chart Polskis, Galgo Españols, Magyar Agars, Peruvian Inca Orchids, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno), & Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande).

All entries in the regular stakes shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club, the United Kennel Club, the National Greyhound Association, the Federation Cynologique Internationale, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a Critique Registration Number (CRN) from the Society for the Perpetuation of Desert Bred Salukis (SPDBS). Limited and/or Provisional stake entries shall be individually registered with the appropriate registry. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with a hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the National Greyhound Registry.

Regular Stakes Offered:

OPEN STAKE: Any eligible sighthound who has met certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record. A photocopy of the hound's registration must be submitted at the hound's first trial. This is waived for NGA greyhounds

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE: Any ASFA Field Champion of record.

VETERAN STAKE: Any eligible hound whose age exceeds six years, except Irish Wolfhounds, whose age shall exceed five years and Whippets, Rhodesian Ridgebacks and Afghan Hounds whose age shall exceed seven years, who has met certification requirements. Points earned in this stake are towards the V-FCH or V-LCM titles.

LIMITED STAKE for Chart Polskis, Galgo Espanols, Magyar Agars, Peruvian Inca Orchids, & Portuguese Podengos that have met certification requirements. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best In Field.

SINGLES STAKE: Any eligible sighthound including novice hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications and/or hounds that have been disqualified from competition in other stakes, are eligible to enter. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles Stake. Limited Breeds are not eligible for these titles. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best In Field.

BEST IN FIELD will be offered on Saturday only.

Conditions of Entry: All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial. If the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more, the stakes will be split into flights by public random draw Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call. Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered; hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Hound certification runs will be offered after completion of the trial on Saturday.

There will be a \$5.00 fine for any loose hounds on the field which are not in the course in progress. There will also be a \$5.00 fine for any one who does not pick up after their dog.

.....DIRECTIONS.....

From points west via the OH Turnpike: Take Exit 118 (U.S. 250/Milan Road) south and look for the signs to Summit Motorsports Park. The facility is located at the intersection of State Routes 18 and 601, two miles east of Norwalk, Ohio. The entrance to the coursing field is on the north side of the street before the main entrance to the dragway.

From points east via the OH turnpike: Take Exit 135 (Route 51/Baumhart Road) south to Route 20 and make a right, heading west. Follow 20 west to Route 601 and make a left, heading south. You will pass the dragway on your right, but continue to State Route 18 and make a right, heading west. Go past the main track entrance and enter the coursing field on the north side of the street.

The coursing field is way in the back after you enter the driveway, so just keep on driving until you see the coursing equipment.
