BREEDS & ELIGIBILITY

ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY

Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirneco dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Pharaoh Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Silken Windhounds, Sloughis, and Whippets. Limited breeds may be entered in the Limited Stake or the Singles Stake. Limited breeds currently include purebred Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Peruvian Inca Orchid, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno), Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande), and must be individually registered with the appropriate registry. All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP & PAL), the NGA, the UKC, the FCI, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a CRN from the SPDBS. A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the NGA.

STAKES OFFERED:

Open – Any eligible sight hound that has met certification requirements excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

Field Champion – Any ASFA Field Champion.

Veteran – Any eligible sight hound that has met qualification requirements and whose age is at least 6 years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least 5 years. Afghans, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Saluki and Whippets whose age shall be at least 7 years.

Limited Stake – Any eligible sight hound of a Limited Stake breed that has met the certification requirements. The winner of this stake is not eligible to compete in Best of Breed and/or Best in Field.

Singles Stake Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles stake. Limited breeds are not eligible for these titles.

Directions to our Lure Field Trial

From the North -

Take I-95 South to 295 South around Richmond to Hopewell exit, for Rt. 10 East. Turn right onto Martin Luther King Highway (VA 40) for five miles, turn left onto Carsley Road (VA 615) for 3.7 miles. Then turn right onto Carsley Road and field will be on the right in about ½ mile

From Jamestown/Williamsburg:

Take VA 31 towards the Jamestown/Scotland Ferry. Ferry is free, but check schedule for departure times. Continue on VA 31 or 14.6 miles, then turn right onto Carsley Road. The field is on the left in 2.9 miles

From the South -

From Emporia, get on Rt. 95 North towards Richmond for 19.8 miles, take Exit 31 (VA 40) towards Waverly/Sussex Courthouse for 28.1 miles. Turn right onto Carsley Road (VA 615) for 3.7 miles. Turn right again onto Carsley Road and field will be on the right in about 1/2 mile.

From Suffolk -

Take 460 West for 20.7 miles. Turn right onto VA 31 for about 5 miles. Turn left onto Carsley Road for 2.9 miles to the field on the left.

From Hampton/Newport News -

Take the James River Bridge (Rt 17S), then turn right onto Brewer's Neck Blvd. (Rt. 32/258) for 2.8 miles. Turn right onto Benn's Church Blvd. (Rt. 10) for 22 miles. Turn left at the light in Surry (VA 10/31) for 10.3 miles. Turn right onto Carsley Road for 2.9 miles to the field on the left.

From Portsmouth/Chesapeake -

Take 17 North into Isle of Wight County (Carrollton). Turn left onto Brewers Neck Blvd. (Rt. 32/258) for 2.8 miles. Turn right onto Benn's Church Blvd. (Rt. 10) for 22 miles. Turn left at the light in Surry (VA 10/31) for 10.3 miles. Turn right onto Carsley Road for 2.9 miles to the field on the left.

Field and Equipment Information:

- .Type of Machine: A battery-powered, continuous- loop machine will be used. A back-up equipment will be available. The lure will consist of highly – visible white plastic bags. The course will be reversed for finals, run-offs, Best of Breed, and again for Best In Field. The field is mown grass and basically level.

- SHOT reserves the right to alter the course plan as required by weather and/or field conditions.

Only the Lure Operator, Hunt master, Judges and handlers of the hounds running in the course in progress will be permitted near the lure machine

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY:

*All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial

*Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more

*Bitches in season, lame hounds and hounds with breed disqualifications will be excused at roll call

*Spayed, neutered, monorchid or cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered

*Hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stakes

*Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched

*All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake), unless excused, dismissed or disqualified

*Hound certification runs will be offered on Saturday after the trial- weather and time permitted

- Substitute entries will be allowed for lame or in-season hounds up until day-of-trial closing.
- **IMPORTANT: A photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with the hound's first ASFA trial entry. This requirement will be waived for hounds registered with the National Greyhound Association.**

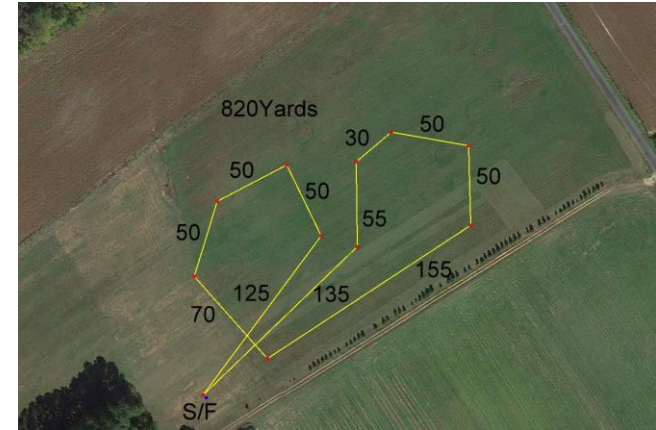
- An **enforced \$5.00 fine** will be imposed for any loose hound not competing in a course in progress.
- Any person may, upon reasonable complaint, be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the ASFA.

Hound Certification Test:

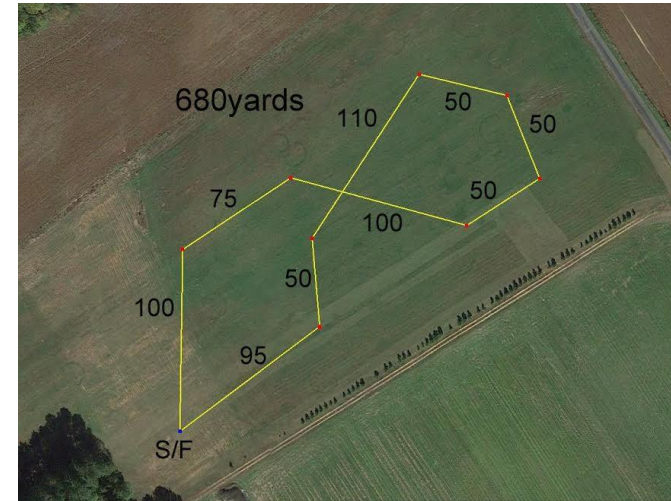
All hounds entered for the *first* time in the Open Stake, Veteran Stake, and/or Limited Stake must have included with their entry a Hound Certification statement signed within the year preceding the closing date for the entry by a regularly licensed Judge. If the hound has completed previously in the Open Stake, Veteran Stake, or Limited Stake, or holds another ASFA approved lure coursing or racing title requiring competition, this certification is not required; however, a Waiver of Requirement for these titles must be included with the entry of a hound competing for the first time. CERTIFICATION AND WAIVER forms are available in the Premium List and/or from the Field Trial Secretary. Certifications will be run Saturday following the trial, time, weather, and equipment permitting. To become certified, a hound must complete a lure course of at least 500 yards, funning with one other hound of the same breed (or of another breed with a similar running style), and show no inclination to interfere with the other hound. If you wish to certify your hound, please arrange for another hound of the same breed or similar running style to be present. No Certification pre-entry is required.

Certification runs will be run on Saturday only, after the trial.

Field Setup

- ◆ Come early (one hour before roll call) and start by carrying equipment.
- ◆ Learn as you go how to place pulleys and tie downs.

Field Clerk

- ◆ Volunteer to help the field clerk for even one or two breeds
- ◆ Learn how scores are tabulated and recorded - when you are comfortable with this you will be able to start helping the field trial secretary.
- ◆ The benefit is you will get a whole new perspective on the course and may learn by listening to the judges.

Runner

- ◆ Volunteer to run paperwork from the field clerk to the field trial secretary after each breed has run.
- ◆ Scores can only be posted as quickly as the paperwork is delivered to the field trial secretary.

Lure Operator

- ◆ Hang around and talk to the lure operator between courses
- ◆ If you are interested, try running the lure around before the trial, at lunch or after the trial at practice.

Practice

- ◆ Give the volunteers who have been working all day a break!
- ◆ Take the practice list, call out the names and collect the money.

Fundraiser

- ◆ It's great when people donate things, but even better if you can organize and execute a fundraiser whether it be a 50/50 draw, silent auction, raffle etc. It doesn't have to be complicated or too time consuming.
