Trial Hours:

Check-in for dogs belonging to the field committee will begin 30 minutes before published trial hours.

Saturday, September 2nd – “Day of” entries close at 7am. Roll Call and Draw to begin at 7:30am with trial to start immediately after the draw.

Certification runs will be offered before the trial for dogs planning to enter this trial. Dogs not entering this trial may certify after the trial completes.

The handler presenting the certifying hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course.

Additional trophies and rosettes will be awarded for the winners of the Kennel and Breeder Stakes, as well as High Scoring Bench Champion.

Eligible Breeds:

This is a Greyhound specialty trial.

General Information:

All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP & PAL), the NGA, or any ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry. A photocopy of

acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the NGA.

Stakes Offered:

OPEN STAKE – Open to Greyhounds excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

FIELD CHAMPION STAKE – Any Greyhound ASFA Field Champion of record.

VETERAN STAKE – Any Greyhound whose age is at least six years. Points go toward V-FCh or V-LCM titles.

SINGLE STAKE – Any Greyhound including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible for Best of Breed. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles stake.

KENNEL STAKE – Highest combined score for two Greyhounds with at least one common owner. Please complete attached entry form.


BREEDER STAKE – Highest combined score for two Greyhounds with at least one common breeder. Please complete attached entry form.

Conditions of Entry:

Hounds must be one year or older on the day of the trial. All hounds will run twice, in trios if possible or braces (except in the Single Stake) unless excused, dismissed or disqualified. Bitches in season and lame hounds will be excused. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a five-minute grace period. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications. Hounds determined to have a breed disqualification at the time of roll call are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake. Spayed, monorchid, cryptorchid, and neutered hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered. Regular stakes will be split if 20 or more entries are present in any one stake at the time of the draw. Any hound that displays aggressive behavior during trial hours will be excused for the day. A penalty of \$5 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress.

Course Plan:

Terrain is natural field with uneven ground. Hounds need to be in top physical condition due to the high elevation. Battery powered continuous loop machine will be used. Backup equipment will be available. Lure will consist of white plastic strips. USRCC reserves the right to alter the course diagram as required by weather and/or field conditions on the day of the trial. The course is **795 yards**, reversed for finals, BOB at the discretion of the judge.



Basic information about the weekend:

The Jackalope Challenge ASFA Greyhound Specialty was envisioned by local Greyhound enthusiasts Faith Burnham and Kimberly Fritzler, and made possible through the support of USRCC and its members. We are thrilled to be hosting the Challenge for its third consecutive year of friendly competition among some of the finest running Greyhounds in the country. We hope you will enjoy your stay in picturesque central Utah, and may your hounds run fast and safe!!

There will be a Port-a-John on site. Bring your own food, water and shade. No littering. Pick up after your dogs, and please haul your garbage off the field. There will be a fine for NOT leaving the field as you found it. Dry camping is available - NO hookups, NO open fires, and NO DUMPING.


