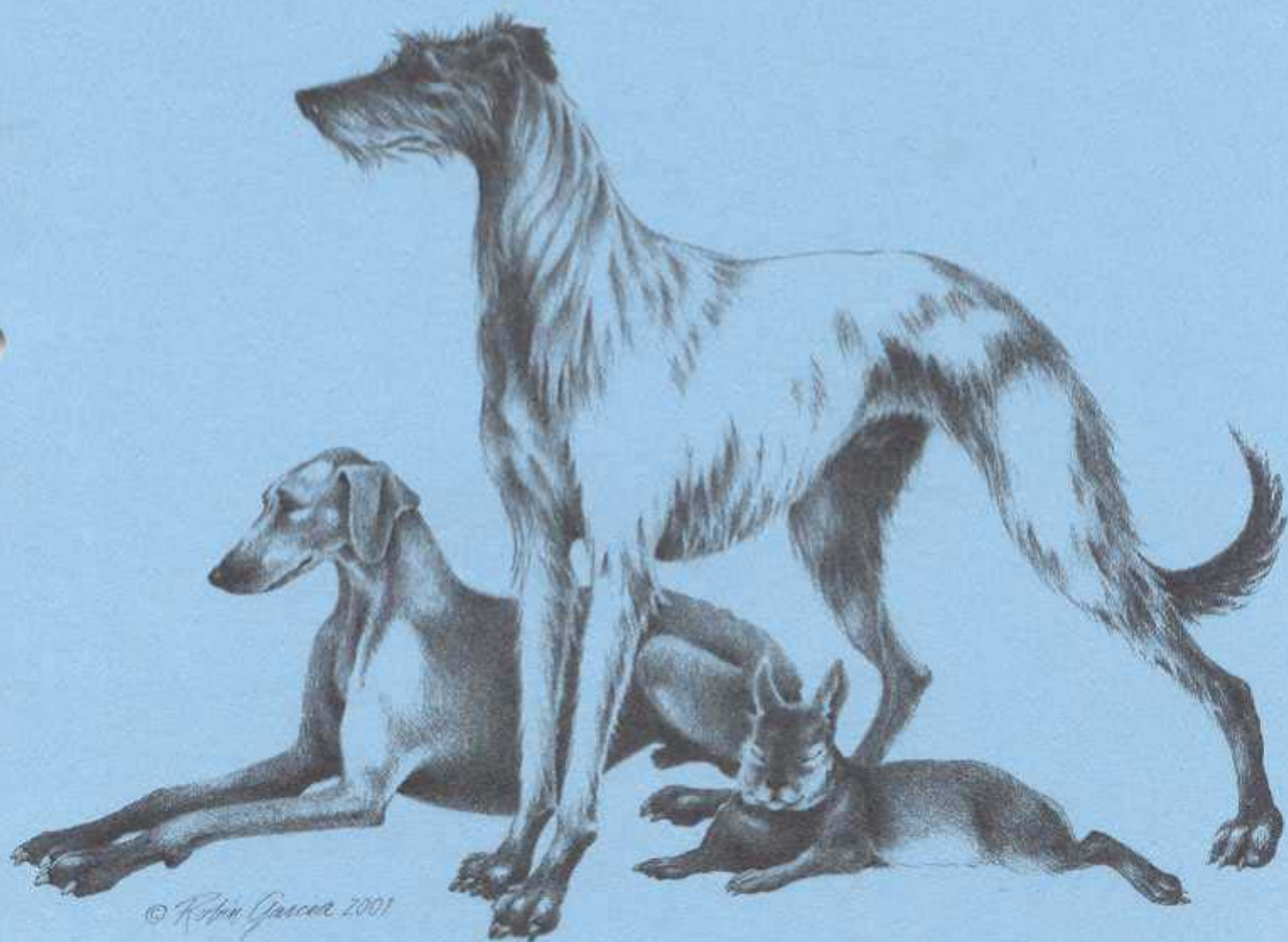

entering the International Invitational

Since the premium for the I.I. is included in this issue of FAN, here are some things to consider when completing and sending in your entries. These will be most helpful to me and make my job a little easier. Thank you.

Please write clearly - the information in the catalogue depends on being able to accurately spell your dog's and your name.

Please include your phone number and e-mail address (preferably e-mail) in case there are questions.

If you are using preprinted entries for your dogs, double check that all the necessary information is on there, such as stake, sex etc. Especially be sure that the top of the entry form has the following:

- 28th ASFA International Invitational
- the date (Saturday, June 4th or Sunday June 5th)
- Entry fee: \$20
- Entries close May 2nd, 2005 - postmarked
- Ping Pirrung, FTS, 156 West Cruikshank Road, Butler, PA 16002-8928

If your dog has multiple titles, please put a comma between each title so they can be put into the catalogue accurately.

Be sure your entries are signed.

When you put your entries in the envelope, it will be most helpful if you could tear or cut the sheets apart so they are separate and put all the entries for Saturday together and then the ones for Sunday. All entries should be approximately 5-1/2 x 8-1/2".

Check your entries again to be sure all the information is accurate and complete.

Use the worksheet to help figure the total amount of your check. There are some questions on the worksheet regarding whether you think you will be purchasing breakfast or lunch; this will help us give the caterer an idea of how much food to have available. It will not be a commitment.

We will have handicapped parking this year and there is a question regarding your need for that on the worksheet as well.

If you send your entries "overnight," please be sure that it doesn't require a signature at delivery. I am often not at home during the day and this will only delay the eventual delivery.

If you have any questions, please contact me. The more we can take care of before the weekend, the easier it will be.
