*Notes from Judges Licensing:*

Chapter XI, Section 7, (b) If the ASFA records indicate that a person has not judged at a trial in the preceding two years, the license shall lapse and the judge shall lose all previous status. Except that, if a licensed judge shall be stationed outside of the United States by a branch of the U.S. Military, and such service makes it impossible for him or her to judge ASFA trials, the time spent out of the U.S. shall not be counted as part of the two year inactive period. Additionally, if there are extenuating circumstances such...

In January I sent out letters to all individuals in jeopardy of losing their license if not judging in 2020. I heard back from several individuals that they had assignments in 2020 and some who had address changes.

Considering all the trials being cancelled so far in 2020 due to COVID-19 and potential for many more to be cancelled, any individual who did not judge in 2019 will not be in jeopardy of losing their judges status in 2021 if they do not judge in 2020.

As soon as this pandemic is under control and trials restart, they should make every attempt to obtain an assignment as soon as possible for the remainder of 2020 or for 2021. They should notify me when they have assignments.
