

Due to the (hopefully) atypical environment in which we find ourselves . . .

- Certifications will be offered after inspection and prior to the trial on Tuesday, June 1, 2021 only. Dogs successfully certifying at that time may enter the trial.
- All attendees must fill out and sign the liability waiver on the following page. Any who do not will be asked to leave the field. This is a legal requirement, and one more stringent than other clubs may have.
- We ask that you observe social distancing guidelines at all times, when not completely impractical.

As for the coursing itself . . .

- SISFA will follow State and local guidelines.
- All Field Committee personnel and Lure Operators will wear facial coverings.
- All participants will wear facial coverings when distancing is not possible.

- No food will be served, bring your own breakfast and lunches. Sorry!!! Please bring your own food, water and shade for yourself and your dogs. None will be available at this time.
- At inspection we will ask the owners of females to wipe their dogs and show the inspection committee the tissue.
- Roll Call will be done at everyone's car, instead of near the FTS's table as in the past. The roll call committee will wear facial coverings.
- Hand sanitizer and wet wipes will be available in the paddock area.
- The porta-potty door will be propped open when not in use for more air flow to cut down on bacteria.
- Huntmasters will stand 6 feet from the dogs after inspecting blankets and slip leads.
- At the starting line, all dogs will stand 6 feet apart.
- Please be aware that the running orders will be posted as usual; if needed, we will use a bull horn to notify you if you choose to stay by your car.

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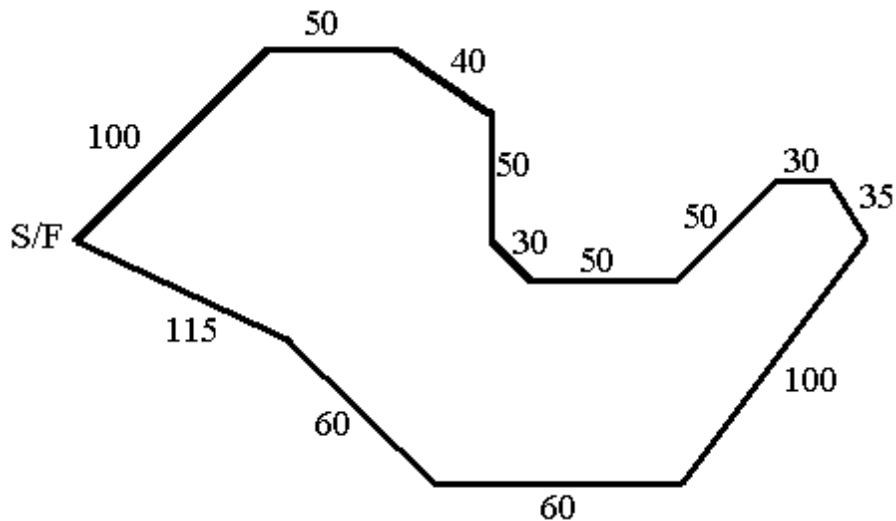

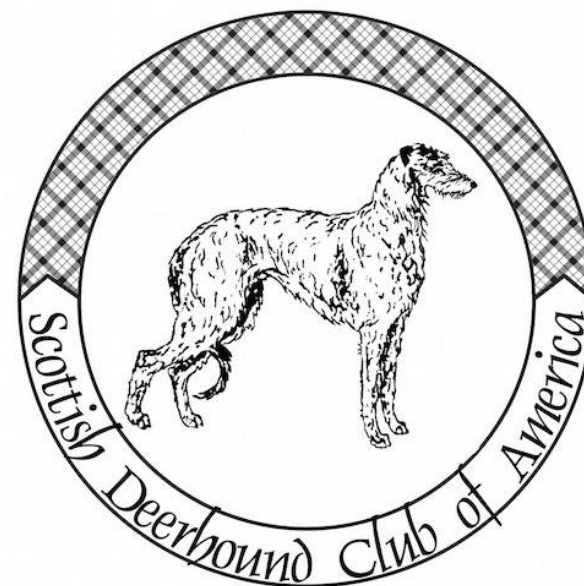
Course plan, diagrammed above, is 770 yards; the course will be reversed for finals, again for BOB.

TRIAL HOURS: 7:30 A.M. until completion. Day of trial entries close at the completion of certifying runs or at 8:00 A.M. Inspection of previously entered hounds will start at 8:00 A.M. Inspection of certifying hounds will start immediately after certification. Rollcall will not start earlier than 8:15 A.M.

ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRY

Only purebred Scottish Deerhounds may be entered.

All entries shall be individually registered with the AKC (including ILP & PAL), the UKC, the FCI, or an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry. **A printed photocopy of acceptable registry must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry.**

INCOMPLETE, UNSIGNED OR CONDITIONAL ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Entries may be emailed to Judi Robinson at jrobin57@hotmail.com but must be accompanied by certification forms and registration if required, and either a payment receipt from the SDCA Store (will be sent when payment is made) or a check for entry fees. Entries will not be acknowledged by mail or telephone. Email, IM, or text Judi for confirmation, jrobin57@hotmail.com or 208-841-0595.

REGULAR STAKES OFFERED

Open Stake: Any eligible Scottish Deerhound excluding ASFA Field Champions of record that have met certification requirements.

Field Champion Stake: Any Scottish Deerhound ASFA Field Champion.

Veteran Stake: Any eligible Scottish Deerhound that has met certification requirements and whose age is at least six years. Points go toward V-Fch or V-LCM titles.

Singles Stake: Any eligible Scottish Deerhound, including those disqualified to run in other stakes. Not eligible to run in Best of Breed. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles from the Singles stake.

Kennel Stake: For Scottish Deerhound; an entry shall consist of two hounds, designated at time of entry in one of the regular stakes, being owned and kenneled by the same person.

Breeder Stake: For Scottish Deerhound; an entry shall consist of two hounds, designated at time of entry in one of the regular stakes, being bred by the same person.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- All entries must be one year or older on the day of the trial, and have a completed hound certification form if entered in open or veteran stake for the first time. First time entered hounds must include a copy of their AKC registration with entry. Entries that do not include the appropriate forms and proof of payment in full will not be accepted.
- Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more.
- Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused at Roll Call and the entry fee will be refunded.
- Spayed, neutered, monorchid, and cryptorchid hounds without breed disqualifications may be entered.
- Hounds with breed disqualifications are not eligible to enter except in the Single Stake.
- Hounds not present at time of Roll Call will be scratched without refund of entry fee.
- Any hound that displays aggressive behavior during trial hours will be excused for the day without refund of entry fee.
- All hounds will run twice in trios, if possible, or braces (except in the Single Stake) unless excused, dismissed, or disqualified.
- A penalty of \$5.00 will be assessed for any loose hound not competing in the course in progress.
- Battery powered, continuous loop lure machine will be used; backup equipment will be available.
