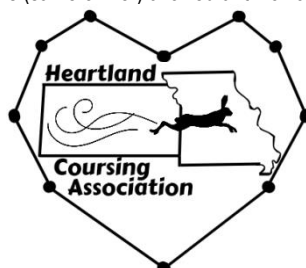

ROLL CALL Sat: 1:00 PM | Sun: 8:30 AM

Each entry will be inspected for breed disqualifications (sighthounds only), lameness, fitness to compete, and bitches in season.

- Early inspection for members of the field committee may begin one-half hour prior to published trial hours.
- Being inspected satisfies roll call. Hounds/dogs not present at roll call will be scratched and entry fee will not be refunded.
- If the inspection committee finds any dog to be lame, unfit to safely compete or a bitch in season, that dog shall not be allowed to enter and entry fees shall be refunded. Bitches in season should be removed from the trial site. Sighthounds found to have breed disqualifications may either withdraw from the trial (entry fee will be refunded) or may move to Singles.

ELIGIBILITY FOR REGIONAL INVITATIONAL

Any hound/dog that has at least one ASFA point, is pointed in its country of residence, or is AKC pointed is eligible to enter a Regional Invitational in an appropriate stake, including Singles Stake, if offered. Proof of non-ASFA points for hounds should be in the form of a photocopy of the certificate, or a page of formal printing, included with the entry. For a Provisional breed to be eligible, the hound must have received a placement with competition. All points or placements must be earned prior to the closing date of the event. An eligible hound/dog may be entered in any number of Regional Invitationals.

SIGHTHOUNDS: ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRIES

Only purebred Afghan Hounds (A), Azawakhs (AZ), Basenjis (BA), Borzoi (B), Cirneco dell'Etna (C), Greyhounds (G), Ibizan Hounds (IB), Irish Wolfhounds (IW), Italian Greyhounds (IG), Peruvian Inca Orchids (PIO), Pharaoh Hounds (P), Rhodesian Ridgebacks (RR), Salukis (S), Scottish Deerhounds (SD), Silken Windhounds (SW), Sloughis (SL), and Whippets (W) may be entered in the regular stakes.

Provisional breeds may be entered in the Provisional Stakes or Singles Stake. Current Provisional breeds are: Chart Polski, Galgo Español, Magyar Agar, Portuguese Podengo (Pequeno, Medio, & Grande), Provisional breeds must be individually registered with the appropriate registry.

All sighthounds shall be individually registered with American Kennel Club (AKC) including Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL), National Greyhound Association (NGA), United Kennel Club (UKC), Federation Cynologique Internationale (FCI), an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry, or possess a critique registration number (CRN) from the Society for the Perpetuation of Desert Bred Salukis (SPDBS).

A photocopy of the registration certificate must be submitted with each hound's first ASFA field trial entry; this requirement is waived for hounds registered with the NGA.

To compete sighthounds:

- A. must be a minimum of 12 months old on the day of the trial
- B. must be physically fit for competition; blindness, lameness & amputation are considered unfit
- C. may be spayed/neutered or intact
- D. may be monorchid or cryptorchid
- E. must not be in heat/season (bitches)
- F. must not be disqualified from ASFA or from any other lure coursing organization

SIGHTHOUNDS: STAKES OFFERED • (No hound may enter more than one stake.)

Open: For any eligible hound that has met certification requirements, excluding ASFA Field Champions* of record. **All hounds entering Open for the first time MUST include a completed ASFA certification, AKC QC form, or waiver form; keep a copy for your records.**

Field Champion: For any ASFA Field Champion* of record.

Veteran: For any hound whose age is at least 6 years, except Irish Wolfhounds whose age shall be at least 5 years, and Afghan Hounds, Ibizan Hounds, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Saluki, and Whippets, and, whose age shall be at least 7 years. **The hound certification requirement also applies to hounds entered in the Veteran stake that have not previously competed in Open.** Points go toward V-FCh or V-LCM titles.*

Provisional: Any eligible sighthound of a Provisional breed that has met certification requirements. Not eligible to compete for Best of Breed, Best in Field, or Best in Event. Points and placements are awarded but no title* certificates are issued until the breed is fully recognized by ASFA.

Singles: Any eligible sighthound including those disqualified to run in other stakes or with breed disqualifications. Each hound runs alone. Not eligible for Best of Breed or Best in Field. Hounds are eligible to earn TCP and CPX titles* from the Singles stake.

Best In Field (BIF) will be offered Sunday only.

Notes:

- Hounds with breed disqualifications are only eligible to enter the Singles Stake.
- Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more.
- All hounds will run twice (prelims & finals), in trios if possible or braces (except in the Singles Stake) unless excused, dismissed, or disqualified.
- *Refer to the [ASFA Running Rules for Lure Field Trials](#) for title details.

NON-SIGHTHOUNDS & SIGHTHOUND MIXES: ELIGIBLE BREEDS & REGISTRIES

All non-sighthounds, sighthound-mixes, and mixed-breeds entered must have a registration number with one of the registries listed below. **A photocopy of the registration certificate must be submitted with each dog's first ASFA field trial entry.**

1. AKC (American Kennel Club)
 - a. Registration as one of the recognized breeds.
 - b. Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) program, which is for purebred dogs that cannot be fully registered with the AKC.
 - c. Canine Partners (CP), which is for mixed-breed dogs and breeds ineligible for AKC registration.
 - d. Foundation Stock Service (FSS), which is for recorded breeds on the road to full AKC recognition.
2. UKC (United Kennel Club) registration as a recognized breed or a Performance Listing (PL) number.
3. If the dog has none of the above registrations, ASFA will provide a unique entry number for a one-time \$10 charge.
 - a. The owner must complete the *Request for ASFA Lure Chasing Instinct Registration Number* form along with the \$10 fee.
 - b. The Trial Secretary will submit a copy of the form with the trial records.
 - c. The owner will retain a copy as proof of request and payment until permanent number is provided.

To compete dogs:

- A. must be a minimum of 12 months old on the day of the trial
- B. must be physically fit for competition; blindness, lameness & amputation are considered unfit
- C. may be spayed/neutered or intact
- D. must not be in heat/season (bitches)
- E. must not be disqualified from ASFA competition or from any other lure coursing organization

NON-SIGHTHOUNDS & SIGHTHOUND MIXES: LCI STAKES OFFERED

No dog may enter more than one stake.

There are three categories/varieties of LCI dogs:

Large: for dogs over 17.5" at the withers

Small: for dogs 17.5" or less at the withers and/or brachycephalic ("flat-faced") dogs

Sighthound Mix: for dogs with any sighthound breed in its background/pedigree

Each of the above three categories/varieties are divided into the following stakes:

Open: for any dog that **has not** achieved the title of LCC*

Excellent: for any dog that **has** achieved the title of LCC*

Veteran: for any dog over the age of 7 years

Notes:

- Small and/or brachycephalic dogs will run 50% of the course up to a maximum of 400 yards. All other dogs will run the full course length.
- All dogs will run twice (prelims & finals).
- All dogs will run singularly.
- All First Time Entered (FTE) Small & Large non-sighthounds will be measured during inspection.
- *Refer to the [ASFA Rules for Lure Chasing Instinct Program](#) for title details.

AWARDS

- Saturday's ribbons are provided by HCA.
- Sunday's ribbons and medallions are provided by the ASFA.
- Ribbons or rosettes will be offered for all placements:
1st = blue, 2nd = red, 3rd = yellow, 4th = white, **Next Best Qualifier (NBQ)** = green,
High Scoring Single = navy/gold, **Best of Breed** = purple/gold, **Best in Field** = red/white/blue
- **LCI High Score:** There will be three LCI High Score awards: one for each LCI variety (Large, Small, Sighthound Mix). The highest combined score wins. If there is a tie, it will be broken using the highest score from prelims or finals, (not including runoff scores). If there is still a tie, the award will be decided by a coin toss.
- We are pleased to offer each dog that earns a new ASFA title at our trial a **New Title rosette**. Please notify the FTS if your dog might earn a new title at our trial.
- Other prizes may be offered by HCA and Friends of HCA.

REGION 5 INVITATIONAL PERPETUAL TROPHIES

Afghan Hound – The McGovern Trophy

The McGovern Trophy was donated by Tom and Pauline McGovern, longtime Des Moines area residents and Iowa Coursing Association Members. Tom and Pauline bred and showed Afghan Hounds, as well as Borzoi, Ibizans and Salukis.

Basenji – The Anubis Cup Trophy

The Anubis Cup Trophy was donated by Daniel and Tomoko Magnan. The Anubis Cup is awarded to the Basenji Best of Breed winner at the Region 5 Regional Invitational. The Anubis Cup recognizes the unique contribution Basenjis make to lure coursing and the canine species' role as man's best friend.

Borzoi – The Ravenwolf Trophy

The Ravenwolf Trophy was donated by John and Susan Weinkein, of Ravenwolf Borzoi, in memory of Ch Ravenwolf Phaedra CD, LCM. Phaedra was one of only a handful of Borzoi to win the triple titles of Ch, CD, and LCM. She placed in the Top Ten in both coursing and obedience standings. Her offspring from two litters achieved AKC championship titles, as well as ASFA Field Championship titles. John and Susan were involved in coursing from 1975 to 2003.

Greyhound – The Savanna Trophy

Donated by Shelly Johnson, the Savanna Trophy is dedicated to two outstanding Greyhounds, whose contributions to ASFA lure coursing will not be forgotten. "Lady", EF Katie Ann, LCM2: Lady's accomplishments in Region 5 included 2 Regional Invitational BOBs, 4 BIFs and winning the "Run for the Bunnies" in 1996. She also honored our region by becoming the #1 ASFA Greyhound in 1994. Sadly, we lost Lady to bone cancer in February 2002. "Beeline", BII Beeline B Quick, LCM 2: Beeline's accomplishments in Region 5 include 2 Regional Invitational BOBs, 8 BIFs, and winning the Harvest Cup (1994), the Minnesota Cup (1995), and the Director's Cup (1996). She was in ASFA Top Ten 3 times and was nominated for the ASFA Hall of Fame twice. In 1998, she brought great honor to Region 5 by winning Best in II at the ASFA's most prestigious event. During the 5 years of Beeline's coursing career, she traveled all over the USA and always remained a wonderful ambassador for our region.

Ibizan – The Treybeau Award

Donated by Treybeau Ibizans, Dean Wright and Sabrina Wright- Hiller, the Treybeau Award for Ibizan Hounds is presented each year to the Best of Breed Ibizan Hound at the Region 5 Invitational in honor of Treybeau Ibizan Hounds past, present and future.

Irish Wolfhound – The Faol Cu Trophy

The Faol Cu Trophy was donated by Gayle K Curtis, Magma Irish Wolfhounds, and IA (Nina) Gottsch, Ianina's Irish Wolfhounds. The trophy is awarded annually To the Best of Breed Irish Wolfhound at the Region 5 Invitational. The purpose is to recognize those qualities that allow the Irish Wolfhound to do the job that it was bred for; including the speed that is required to catch its prey, and the strength that is needed to dispatch it.

Rhodesian Ridgeback – The Lion's Trophy

The Lion's Trophy was donated by Dawn Gibas and Scott Tracey. The trophy is offered in recognition of the power, stamina, and "lion's" heart that is demonstrated both on and off the field by this wonderful breed. The perpetual trophy honors the champions of today, and pays homage to the legacy of those champions who have passed this way before.

Saluki - The AmunRa Cup

The AmunRa Cup was donated by Kathy Nelson in recognition of all the beautiful Salukis, and the unending stamina that they demonstrate at these lure trials. The AmunRa Cup honors those that have gone before and have set high standards for those that follow. Each year the winner of the trophy will add a photo as the winning hound.

Whippet – The Northwind Cup

The Northwind Cup is offered in honor of "Dash", Can CH Northwind's Dash to Bryton, Am/Can FCh, Am/Can CD by Kay Nierengarten and Mark Shubert. Dash, a strong, powerful runner, retired at five, when he sustained permanent injury on the coursing field. He was 30 points short of an LCM, and 12 points short of a Can. FCHX with all placements. We applaud his indomitable spirit, which survived complete paralysis on the field, a dislocated vertebrae, displaced spinal cord and ten weeks in a body cast before resuming many normal activities.

Rescue - The Skeeex Trophy

The Skeeex Trophy honors Skeeex LCM2. Skeeex was a rescued Basenji. The trophy is awarded to the highest scoring rescue of any breed at the Region 5 Invitational. The dog must have been adopted from a shelter or legitimate rescue organization, must have an ILP/PAL number, must be spayed or neutered, and have earned a qualifying score. This trophy was donated by Micky Rubin to symbolize that broken lives can be repaired.

Best In Field – The Directors' Cup

The Directors' Cup is a perpetual trophy originated in 1992 by Region 5 Director, Frank Zaworski, to honor the hound winning Best in Field at the Region 5 Invitational. Frank Zaworski became involved in lure coursing in 1968 and has been judging coursing trials since 1973. He and his wife, Linda, have been involved with Whippets since 1977.

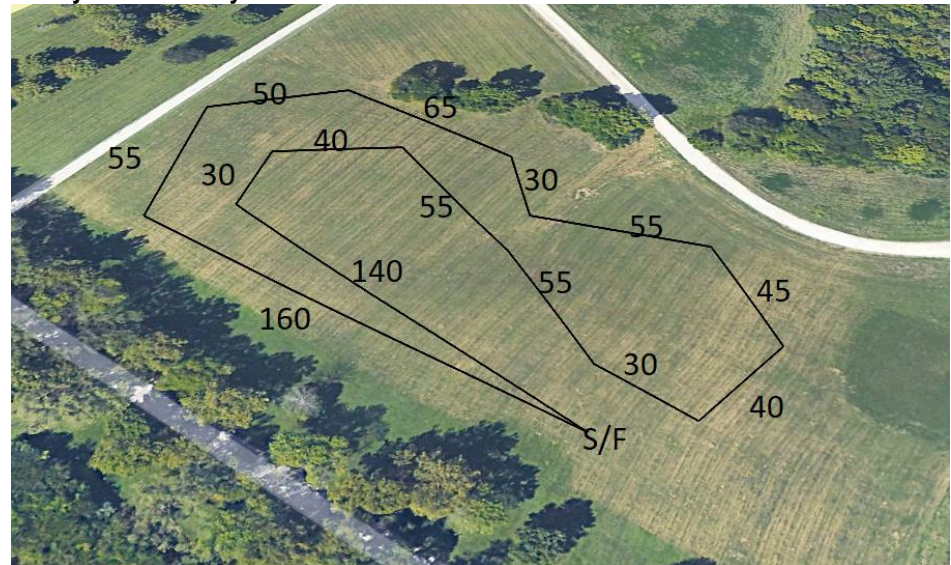
COURSE PLANS & EQUIPMENT

HOW TO ENTER

- Pre-entry: mail completed entry form and payment to the Trial Secretary. Do NOT send entries "signature required". Electronic entries are not accepted.
- Gate entry: bring entry form and payment to the event before close of entries.
- Checks should be made payable to: Heartland Coursing Association.
- If you have questions about how to enter, contact the Trial Secretary.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Separate entry forms and entry fees are required for each dog.
2. A fee of \$35.00 will be assessed for any returned checks.
3. Incomplete, unsigned, conditional, or unpaid entries will not be accepted.
4. The Club and/or Trial Secretary assume no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry form.
5. Hounds must be ready for judging. Judges need not wait for dogs that hold up the trial.
6. Field Trial Chairman may excuse, or levy & collect a penalty fee of \$5 from the owner (or duly authorized agent) of any hound that is loose on the field and not in competition at the time.
7. Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds by the Field Committee. Children must be under the control of their parents or guardian at all times.
8. Only the lure operator, huntmaster, judges and handlers of the course in progress will be permitted near the lure operating equipment.

REFUNDS

HCA issues entry fee refunds for dogs that are in season or lame. If your dog comes in season or becomes lame before the trial and you will not be attending the trial for these reasons, you must inform the Field Trial Secretary BEFORE roll call to request a refund.

TIPS FOR HANDLERS

1. It is strongly recommended that prior to running your hound, you have good recall control over your dog, as the dogs will run off leash.
2. Handlers should wear comfortable, sturdy shoes (no sandals or flip flops) and be physically able to hold and release their dogs, as well as catch them.
3. Handlers may carry toys, whistles or small treats to reward and assist with retrieving their hound at the completion of their run. Treats may not be excessive to the point of distracting other hounds.
4. The Huntmaster will instruct the handler to "Retrieve your hound" upon completion of the run. The handler is expected to promptly secure the hound and leave the field with the hound on leash.
5. Handlers are advised to warm up their hound prior to their run and walk them for approximately 10 minutes afterwards.
6. Coursing is a physically demanding sport and can tax a hound's physical strength. Hounds that are old, have breathing or heart problems, are overweight, or are out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. Consult your veterinarian if you have concerns.
7. Muzzles are not required but are permitted at the handler's discretion.
8. Head halters, such as the Gentle Leader or Halti, may be used on the grounds but must not be worn while running the course.
9. Please do not bring bitches known to be in season to the field.

SITE INFORMATION

Porta-potty will be available. Please bring your own drinking water. Limited shade trees available. Please clean up after your dog and yourself.
