

Welcome to the Teen Lure Courser Program!

How to get started.

Send a check for \$10.00 made out to **ASFA** to Rita Linck, 2114 Coral Drive, Arlington, Tx 76010, <u>AriaBorzoi@yahoo.com</u>. Remember to submit a note with the check that includes your name, address, phone number and age.

What happens next?

You will receive a package that includes all that is needed to achieve your goal of becoming a Teen Lure Courser. This package includes: the guidelines, judges' forms, the evaluation forms for each event, and your completion certificate for the three different classes.

OK, I have all of this stuff. Now what do I do?

<u>All persons involved must be notified before the trial that you want to participate in the Teen</u> <u>Lure Courser program. Therefore, before you start participating in the events, you **must** first contact the Field Trial Secretary of the club hosting the ASFA trial.</u>

Each event requires a person on the field committee, a judge or a member of the club to do the evaluations of your work. After you complete each event, you will send the judges' copy to Rita Linck (see above for address) and keep the other copy for your records. As each class of events is completed with a qualifying score, you will receive a gold seal to be placed on your certificate.

When all three levels of classes are completed with a qualifying score, you will then receive your **Teen Lure Courser** certificate.
